Pre-Conference Critical Needs Training Workshops**

Half- Day Session Descriptions

- **OFRD Deployment Training Aboard a Navy Ship**--This training on ship-based missions will be done in partnership with the U.S. Navy. Training will be offered in a morning session and an afternoon session aboard a U.S. Naval Vessel. Topics covered will include proper shipboard etiquette; details about USPHS humanitarian missions; and information on shipboard life and daily routines. **Cost: \$35 (includes round-trip transportation).**

- **Scientific Writing:** This half-day workshop (afternoon) takes an active, participatory approach to help public health professionals learn how to communicate the findings of their work more effectively and expedite publication of their work. Working in small groups, students will critique actual published and unpublished manuscripts, and participate in a wide range of exercises that exemplify the real-world challenges that authors face. **Cost: \$25**

- **The Office of the Surgeon General Protocol and Etiquette Workshop:** This session will provide attendees with the protocol and etiquette intelligence to propel officers to senior rank status. The workshop includes lunch where you will learn to “dine like a diplomat.” **Cost: \$50 (includes lunch).**
